

# 2008 KNOX COUNTY SUMMER HIGH SCHOOL

For students who attended grade 9, 10, 11 or 12 during 2007-2008 school year

## INFORMATION AND REQUEST

**Location:** Central High School, 5321 Jacksboro Pike, Knoxville, TN 37918

**Dates:** Tuesday, May 27 – Monday, July 21 (34 days)

**Daily Schedule:** Summer School will be held Monday through Thursday (except for Friday – May 30, and July 18). Each class will be four (4) hours, **8:30 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.** Students enrolled for a full credit and those enrolled in a half-credit course (i.e., Driver Education or American Government) offered the first seventeen (17) day period must report on May 27. Students only enrolled in a half-credit course (i.e., Driver Education, Economics) offered the second seventeen (17) day period must report on Tuesday, June 24. Classes will be offered as make-up credit and new credit for students identified and approved by their base school who are not on track to graduate within NCLB guidelines. Summer School will offer **ONE SUBJECT, ONE CREDIT** (except for American Government - 1/2 cdt, Economics - 1/2 cdt, Driver Education - 1/2 cdt).

**Fee:** The cost of summer school is **\$120.00** except for American Government and Economics, which are **\$60** each. Fees must be paid first day of the student's summer session. Fees will not be accepted or students admitted to class after the first day of the session. Fee is nonrefundable. **Exemptions:** Students receiving free or reduced price meals in a Knox County high school in 2007-2008 may apply for exemption of class fee on the first day class meets.

**Subjects:** The following classes will be offered pending sufficient enrollment. **Students are responsible for registering for correct class** and are advised to see their regular school guidance counselor before registering.

\* If prerequisite for college entrance requirement, a 2008 graduate may enroll.

\*\* Driver Education training only will have a choice of taking these courses in one of two 17-day periods (May 27 - June 23 or June 24 - July 21)

\*\*\* American Government – May 27- June 23 / Economics – June 24 - July 21

♦ Prerequisite: 15 years of age / All students must meet state requirements for attendance and academic progress.

**Make-up Credit:** Students may make up a full-unit grade of “C, D” or “F” received in a Block Schedule course by attending 34 days. Students MAY NOT repeat in summer school a course in which they received a grade of “A” or “B”.

**Grades:** A numerical percent progress report will be issued at the end of the first 17 days. A cumulative numerical percent will be reported at the end of the session.

**Breaks:** Snacks will be available at additional costs during breaks.

**Transportation:** Students responsible for own transportation.

**Attendance: NO ABSENCES!** Each summer school day equals a regular school week. **A student will be dropped from class upon the first absence, the second tardiness of more than one hour, or the sixth (6) tardiness of any length.** Students enrolled in American Government, Economics, or Driver Education will be dropped on the third (3) tardy.

**Discipline:** Student will be dropped from summer school for violation of school rules. (See other side of form.)

*Students enrolled in a Knox County public high school will turn in registration form to their guidance counselor.

## KNOX COUNTY SUMMER HIGH SCHOOL

### STUDENT INFORMATION AND RULES

Summer school moves at a pace five times as fast as regular school. Each 4-hour class covers about one week's lessons. For this reason, full attendance and attention in class is required.

All rules are strictly enforced. Students come from many schools with different standards. But summer school has only one set of rules to assure that everyone is safe, secure, and free from distractions. Students who abide by the rules will find that you are welcome.

1. NO ABSENCE. Students will be DROPPED FROM A CLASS upon the first absence.
2. NO EARLY DISMISSAL from class.
3. TARDINESS. Students will be DROPPED FROM A CLASS on the sixth tardiness of any length and on the second tardiness of more than one hour. American Government, Economics, and Driver Education students will be dropped on the third tardy.

**The Administration reserves the right to determine when a tardy of more than an hour becomes an absence.**

6. All students must follow rules of their teachers and obey any faculty member while attending summer school.
5. All assigned work must be completed to receive credit.
6. Students are responsible for their textbooks; lost books must be paid for before credit is received.
7. All fees must be paid on the first day of class, or the student will not be permitted to enroll in summer school. Returned checks may result in the student's being dropped from the course. Fees are not refunded for any reason once the class meets.
8. Students' dress and grooming are regulated to the extent that they do not interfere with the educational process or personal safety as determined by the administration. Gang symbols are strictly prohibited. Violators will BE DROPPED FROM SUMMER SCHOOL.
9. Students are to park in the large student parking lot only. After arriving and parking the vehicle, students are not permitted to return to the vehicle or the parking lot at any time except when departing for the day. Violation will result in BEING DROPPED FROM SUMMER SCHOOL.
10. Students in possession of a weapon will be DROPPED FROM SUMMER SCHOOL and turned over to law enforcement.
11. Students under the influence, in possession of, or using drugs or alcohol will be DROPPED FROM SUMMER SCHOOL.
12. Students using or in the possession of tobacco products will be DROPPED FROM SUMMER SCHOOL.
13. Valuables such as money, pocketbooks, etc., are the responsibility of the student.
14. No radios or tape players are permitted.
15. Students are not to be out of class at any time except for scheduled breaks. In the event of an emergency, students must have a pass from their teacher.
16. Conduct by any student that is prejudicial to good order or discipline, as determined by the administration, may result in that student being DROPPED FROM SUMMER SCHOOL.
